- Certificate of final graduation(if applicants are attending school, enrollment certificate)
  - 1) Apostille countries : Apostille certificate with English translation
  - 2) Non Apostille countries : Certified by Korean consulate

- ※ For Chinese Applicants Credentials report of education Verification Report of Graduation issued by China Academic Degrees & Graduate Education Development Center  
 \*Issuing organization – www.chsi.com.cn / www.cdgd.edu.; Should be submitted with copies of graduation certificate and transcript) However, Vocational high school graduates from China should choose one of the following items.
  - ① Certificate of graduation issued by the school (provided by Provincial Education Office + must be verified in Korean Consulate in China)
  - ② Certificate of graduation issued by Provincial Education Office (must be confirmed by the Korean Consulate in China)
- Certificate of final academic transcript
  - 1) Apostille countries : Apostille Certificate and English translation
  - 2) Non Apostille countries : Certified by Korean consulate



- 1) Purpose of Experience : To understand Korea and Korean culture through various cultural experiences as well as learning Korean.
- 2) Number of experiences : 1 to 2 times per semester
  - Spring and autumn: Group cultural experience / Summer and winter semesters : various cultural experience depending on their level
- 3) Cultural experience activities
  - Beginning of semester : Campus Tour, Regional (Busan/Gimhae) City Tour
  - Spring semester : Cherry blossom festival
  - Summer semester : Industrial inspection (Samsung Motors, POSCO, etc.) or Busan port tour (container ship experience)
  - Fall semester : Experience Yangdong Village(UNESCO Cultural Heritage) in Gyeongju
  - Winter semester : Christmas festival, snow sled festival



**G Academic Information**

- 1) Grade Evaluation : quizzes, mid-term, and final exams
- 2) Level completion : Students must attend 70% of the total class hours and receive score over 70% to complete a level.
  - Those who have attendance rate of 70% or higher and grades with 60 to 70% will have a chance to take the placement test to go to the next level.
  - Students who fails to pass the class for 3 times will not be allowed to register the program any longer
  - Students who miss more than 80 hours in one term, and miss or choose not to take the tests, will not be allowed to register the program any longer.
  - 3 tardies or 3 early leaves, equals 1 absence
  - If students were absent due to a legitimate reason, please submit supporting documents.
  - Certificate of completion will be provided to those who are approved to go to the next level
  - Academic Excellence Award : A scholarship of KRW 250,000 shall be granted to the students who received the highest score in each class and re-register for the next semester.



- A person who meets the qualifications for academic background and Korean language proficiency and both his/her parents and himself/herself foreigners
- Freshman : High school (expected) graduates
  - Transfer : International students who have graduated(are expected to graduate) from 2-3 year universities or completed at least two years at a university in Korea or abroad 9

**Required documents**

- Application form and personal statement (school form): A photo must be attached
- Consent form for academic history verification(school form)
- Certificate of final graduation(certification of enrollment)
  - 1) Freshman : High school (expected) graduation certificate
  - 2) Transfer : Completion certificate of a college or (expected) graduation certificate or degree certificate
- Certificate of final academic transcript
- Copy of applicant and the parents' alien registration card(domestic residents only)
- Certificate of foreign nationality issued by the foreign government(copy of citizenship or passport, etc.)
  - ※ Chinese applicants must submit the household register(resident registration card) of themselves and their parents. If the place of residence is different, additional family relations notarization certificate must be submitted.
- Documents related to the demonstration of Korean proficiency (If there are no documents related to demonstrate Korean proficiency, applicants must pass Inje university Korean proficiency test)
- Proof of financial capability
  - 1) Bank statement or domestic remittance or currency exchange certificate of more than US \$18,000
  - 2) Pledge for the burden of expenses for studying abroad (school form)
- Others: Various qualification certificates, awards, foreign language proficiency test transcripts(reports) (Those who can submit)
  - ※ Documents in foreign languages other than English, must be submitted with Korean translated notarization.
  - ※ Successful applicants might have to submit additional documents related to issuance of their visa.
  - ※ Final successful applicants should submit certificate of graduation, transcript, certificate of enrollment issued by the relevant government with Apostille confirmation. Applicants from non-Apostille countries should submit "confirmation of consul" from the Korean Consulate in the relevant country. (Not required for graduates from overseas Korean schools recognized by the Ministry of Education)
  - ※ Those who graduated from a China based school, must submit a certification report issued by the Ministry of Education of China



## 03. Evaluation method

Method
100% Interview examination

- Interview Examination Method
  - A perfect score of 100 points including personality, major aptitude, mathematics ability, interview attitude, expression ability, specialties (foreign language, computer skills, various award performance, various certificates, etc.) will be reviewed.
  - ※ Applicants must bring their ID card for the interview. Those who do not bring their ID card will be rejected take the interview and treated as unqualified.

## 04. Eligibility for application

International students whose parents and applicants both have foreign nationality and meets the following "Academic requirement" and "Korean proficiency qualifications."

### A. Academic requirement

Type	Eligibility Requirements
Freshman	High school graduates or expected graduates ※ Domestic high school graduates ※ Those who have completed or is expected to complete the curriculum corresponding to the domestic high school curriculum in a foreign country. ※ Those who have transferred to a domestic school from the high school of the home country and graduated from the high school of the home country or are expected to graduate.
Transfer	Graduates from domestic or overseas 2-3 year universities or graduates who have studied at a 4-year university for more than 2 years. ※ Those who have completed(expected to complete) the second year of a four-year university(including Korean communication and Industrial University), 2nd year completion is according to the university regulations. ※ Those who graduated from a vocational college(In the case of a three-year college, applicants must be(expected)graduates) ※ Those who have obtained(expected to obtain) a bachelor's degree or higher in accordance with the Credit Recognition Act and the LifeLong Education Act(Students with bachelor's degree program must acquire a total of 80 credits or more) ※ Those who have obtained an undergraduate degree(including those who passed the credit recognition system or self-study system, etc.) or those who are recognized as having an equivalent academic background or higher.

### B. Korean language proficiency qualification : Applicants who meets at least one or more of the following two items.

- 1) Applicants with TOPIK level 3 or above
- 2) Applicants who passed Inje University Korean language proficiency test
  - Applicants who do not meet item 1) shall be considered as eligible only if they pass the Korean language proficiency test conducted by this university.
  - ※ Undergraduate students need to obtain TOPIK level 4 or above to graduate(graduation requirement)

- 4) Certificate of final academic transcript
- 5) Copy of applicant and the parents' alien registration cards (Domestic residents only)

  - ※ Chinese applicants must submit the household register of the applicants and their parents.  
If the residence of the applicant and the parents are different, they must submit additional certificates of kinship.
- 7) Document proving Korean language proficiency(If there are no documents related to verify Korean language proficiency, applicants must take Korean Language Proficiency Test at this university)
- 8) Proof of financial capability
  - Bank statement or domestic remittance or currency exchange certificate of more than US \$18,000
  - Affidavit of Financial Support(school form)



- 9) Additional documents: Various qualification certificates, awards, foreign language proficiency test transcripts(reports) (Those who can submit)
  - Documents in foreign languages other than English, must be submitted with Korean translated notarization.
  - ※ Successful applicants might have to submit additional documents related to the issuance of their visa.
  - ※ Final successful applicants should submit certificate of graduation, transcript, certificate of enrollment issued by the relevant government with Apostille confirmation. Applicants from non-Apostille countries should submit "confirmation of consul" from the Korean Consulate in the relevant country.(Not required for graduates from overseas Korean schools recognized by the Ministry of Education)
  - ※ Those who graduated from a China based school, must submit a certification report issued by the Ministry of Education of China

    - China Ministry of Education Degree <http://www.cdgc.edu.cn>
    - However, those who graduated vocational high school from china must submit either ① or ② of following items :
      - ① Certificate of graduation issued by the school (provided by Provincial Education Office + must be verified in Korean Consulate in China)
      - ② Certificate of graduation issued by Provincial Education Office (must be confirmed by the Korean Consulate in China)

## 06. Evaluation criteria

- 1) The applicants are selected according to the results of the examination by each recruitment unit.
- 2) If the admission assessment determines that applicant does not have academic ability, they may not be selected.
- 3) Those who fail the interview will be disqualified.
- 4) There will be no separate standard for applicants who received the same score and will be admitted as is.
- 5) If two or more interviewees give '0' points in the interview, applicants will be treated as disqualified.
- 6) Admission will be canceled if the reason for disqualification is found in the documents submitted by the final successful applicants.
- 7) If applicants are found to have entered the school illegally(fraudulent methods), applicants' admission will be canceled(discharged) even during the semester.

## 07. Application fee

- 1) Application fee: 50,000 won
- 2) The application fee can be returned only in the following cases :
  - In cases when applicants could not take the test due to natural disasters, disease, and other accidents, etc., which are not attributable to the applicants(simple absence not included)
  - Those who are not qualified for application : Full refund of the application fee
- ※ The fee will be returned to the account entered in the application, and the applicants will be responsible for any disadvantages caused by the mistakes(error) in entering the refund account.
- ※ If the account number is changed after submitting the application, applicants must contact the Office of International Affairs in advance to modify it.
- ※ All application fee will not be refunded even if the admission is rejected.

## 08. Notes for applicants

- 1) Those who have been accepted at two or more universities must register only one university.
- 2) Applicants are not allowed to apply for more than one department (Dual application not allowed.)
- 3) Violation of prohibited provisions (dual registration, etc.) or a reason for disqualification is found, the admission will be canceled immediately.
- 4) Documents in foreign languages other than English must be translated and notarized into Korean.
- 5) During the application period, all announcement and notices will be posted on the website of Office of International Affairs and will not be notified individually.
- 6) Documents and admission fee will not be returned and can not be corrected after submission.
- 7) If successful candidates fail to pay the payment within a certain date, the acceptance will be canceled.
- 8) Applicants and their guardians are solely responsible for the loss of qualifications (including additional qualifications) due to the interruptions of contact.
- 9) If a successful applicant has also been accepted to another university and are not willing to enroll this university, must submit a waiver of registration to the Office of International Affairs upon receipt of the acceptance letter (within 12 hours)
- 10) In order to prepare for various accidents, illnesses, successful applicants will be enrolled in the National Health Insurance after enrollment. Non-payment of the insurance may lead to restrictions on their stay, receiving scholarships, and registering classes.
- 11) Matters not specified in this guideline shall be determined by the International Affairs Committee of this university.

## 09. Notes on application

- 1) Application form must be entered (written) correctly.
- 2) The contents of the application must be consistent with the facts, and the applicant is responsible for the disadvantages caused by the mistake.
- 3) The name, alien registration number must be accurately entered according to the alien registration card.
- 4) Applicants and guardians' addresses and phone numbers should be filled with the number that can be contacted at any time during the admission period. If there is any change in contact number during admission, applicants must notify the office of international Affairs.



## 10. Personal Information Collection and Usage Agreement

- 1) Applicant' data such as personal information etc. will be collected and used for the university admission screening.
  - collected personal information: name, alien registration number, address, phone number, e-mail, school record (student certificate, transcript), (expected) graduation year, refund account number, etc.
  - School information: High school name, high school phone number, e-mail, fax number, etc.
- 2) The collected personal information will not be used for any purpose other than admission, scholarships, academics, statistical work, immigration, or other guides provided by the university. If the information is no longer being used, it will be destroyed immediately.





**Using Transportation**


1) Public transportation in Gimhae and Busan

In Korea, public transportation networks such as buses and subways are well developed, and there is a transfer system between buses and subways, allowing visitors to visit Gimhae and Busan at a low cost.

What you need is a transportation card. You can buy transportation cards at convenience stores and use them after charging a certain amount of money. The transit system can be transferred up to three times : subway + bus + subway or bus + subway + bus + bus.

## Yeonji Park

2) Light Rail Inje Station → Take off at Yeonji Station

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## Gimhae Suro Royal Tombs

The Royal Tomb of King Suro was the founder of Gimhae Kim Clan, Heo Clan, and Incheon Yi Clan. It is a royal tomb dedicated to King Suro who founded Garakguk. King Suro is said to have been named "Suro" because it was the first egg to come out.


- **Location** : 26, Garak-ro 93beon-gil (Seosang-dong)
- **Time required** : 20 minutes
- **How to go** : Bus in front of the school (No. 8) → Royal Tomb of King Suro



## Buwon I-Square Mall(Lotte Cinema)

- **Location** : 2342 Gimhae-daero, Gimhae-si (Buwon-dong)

At the top of Bonsungsan Mountain, where the observatory is located, you can see the panoramic view of Gimhae City at a glance. At night, you can observe the stars. you can enjoy the mysterious celestial bodies of the universe and the beauty of the night sky.

## Haeundae

Haeundae Beach is the most famous beach in Korea. Around the island of Dongbaek, There are many things to see and enjoy throughout the year, such as the Moon Greetings and Oryukdo Island is rich in various attractions and entertainment.

### How to go (1 hour and 30 minutes)

- 1) Take a bus on the other side of the main gate of the campus(128-1, 8, 8-1) → Get off at Deokcheon Intersection → (200) Transfer - Get off at Haeundae Station
- 2) In front of the school (No. 128-1, 8, 8-1) → Deokcheon Subway Station → Get off at Haeundae Station on Subway Line 2.
- 3) Use the school bus heading to Haeundae
- 4) Light Rail Inje Station : Transfer to Daeje Station on Subway Line 3 → Transfer to Suyeong Station on Subway Line 2 → Get off at Haeundae Station

## Busan Aquarium

The Busan Aquarium is a world-class undersea theme aquarium located in Haeundae. Various events and special exhibitions are being held throughout the year.

### How to go (1 hour and 30 minutes)

- 1) Take a bus on the other side of the main gate of the campus(128-1, 8, 8-1) → Get off at Deokcheon Intersection → (No. 200) Transfer → Get off at Haeundae Station
- 2) Take a bus on the other side of the main gate of the campus(128-1, 8, 8-1) → Deokcheon Subway Station → Get off at Haeundae Station on Subway Line 2.
- 3) Using the school bus heading to Haeundae
- 4) Light Rail Inje Station : Transfer to Daeje Station on Subway Line 3 → Transfer to Suyeong Station on Subway Line 2 → Get off at Haeundae Station



## Gwanganri

Along with Haeundae Beach, it is a famous tourist destination representing Busan. It is close to the city center, convenient transportation, and clear water and moderate waves make it a perfect place for summer rest. You can also see the wonderful night view of Gwangan Bridge at night.

### How to go (1 hour and 30 minutes)

- 1) Take a bus on the other side of the main gate of the campus(128-1, 8, 8-1) → Deokcheon Subway Station → Exit 3 and 5 of Gwangan Station on Subway Line 2, Exit 1 and 3 of Geumryonsan Station
- 2) Light Rail Inje Station : Transfer to Subway Daeje Station Line 3 from Gyeongjeon Subway Daeje Station → Transfer to Subway Line 2 from Suyeong Station → Get off at Gwangan Station.
