- Purpose of Experience: To understand Korea and Korean culture through various cultural experiences as well as learning the Korean language.
- Number of experiences: 1 to 2 times per term
 - Spring and autumn: Group cultural experience activities
 - Summer and winter term: Various cultural experience activities depending on their level
- Cultural experience activities
 - Beginning of a term: Campus Tour, Regional (Busan/Gimhae) City Tour
 - Spring term: Cherry Blossom Festival
 - Summer term: Industrial inspection (Samsung Motors, POSCO, etc.) or Busan port tour (container ship experience)
 - Fall term: Experience Yangdong Village (UNESCO Cultural Heritage) in Gyeongju
 - Winter term: Christmas Festival, Snow Sled Festival

Academic Information

- Grade Evaluation: quizzes, mid-term, and final exams
- Level completion: Students must attend 70% of the total class hours and receive score over 70% to complete a level.
 - Those who have an attendance rate of 70% or higher and grades with 60 to 70% will have a chance to take the placement test to achieve the next level.
 - Students who fail to pass the class 3 times will not be allowed to register the program anymore
 - Students who miss more than 80 hours in one term, and miss or choose not to take the test, will not be permitted to re-register or continue the program.
 - 3 late records or 3 early leaves, equals 1 absence.
 - If students are absent due to a legitimate reason, please submit supporting documents.
 - Certificate of completion will be provided to those who are approved to go to the next level.
 - Academic Excellence Award: A scholarship of KRW250,000 shall be granted to the students who achieved the highest score in each class and re-register for the next term



B Eligibility for Application

- 1) Applicants who meet the qualifications for academic background and Korean language proficiency. Applicants and their parents must have a foreign citizenship.
 - Freshman: High school (expected) graduates
 - Transfer: International students who have graduated (or are expected to graduate) from 2–3 year universities or completed at least two years at a university in Korea or abroad.
- ※ Applicants must have either TOPIK level 3 (or above) or pass the Korean Language Proficiency Test given by Inje University.

C Required Documents

- Application form and personal statement (school form): A photo must be attached
- Consent form for academic history verification (school form)
- Certificate of final graduation (certificate of enrollment)
 - 1) Freshman: High school (expected) graduation certificate
 - 2) Transfer: Completion certificate of a college, (expected) graduation certificate, or degree certificate
- Certificate of final academic transcript
- Copy of applicant and the parents' alien registration card (domestic residents only)
- Certificate of foreign nationality issued by the respective foreign government (copy of citizenship or passport, etc.)
 - ※ Chinese applicants must submit proof of residency – this includes the resident registration card of both student and parents. If the place of residence is different, additional family relations notarization certificate must be submitted.
- Documents related to the demonstration of Korean proficiency (If there are no documents related to demonstrate Korean proficiency, applicants must pass the Inje university Korean proficiency test)
- Proof of financial capability
 - 1) Bank statement, domestic remittance, or currency exchange certificate of more than USD18,000
 - 2) Pledge for the burden of expenses for studying abroad (school form)
- Others: Various qualification certificates, awards, foreign language proficiency test transcripts (optional)
 - ※ Documents in foreign languages other than English, must be accompanied with Korean translated notarization.
 - ※ Successful applicants might have to submit additional documents related to the issuance of their visa.
 - ※ Final successful applicants should submit certificate of graduation, transcript and certificate of enrollment issued by the relevant government with apostilled confirmation. Applicants from non-apostille countries should submit the documents with consular confirmation from the Korean Consulate in the relevant country. (Not required for graduates from overseas Korean schools recognized by the Ministry of Education)
 - ※ Those who graduated from a China-based school, must submit a certification report issued by the Ministry of Education of China



 - Applicants must have completed both primary and secondary education, which is comparable to 16 years education at elementary, middle and high school, and college in Korea.

- 50% of tuition waiver is applicable to full-time students who are admitted without choosing the requirements for the 85% scholarship listed above.
- The scholarship recipients must fulfill the duties of RA (Research Assistant) or TA (Teaching Assistant) for the time according to their academic advisor's instruction.

3) Financial Support through Brain Korea 21(BK21) Program
 Departments of Nanoscience & Engineering, U-Design, Digital Anti-aging Health Care are participating in the BK21 Program supported by the National Research Foundation in Korea. Graduate students enrolled in BK21 departments can receive monthly stipend (KRW700,000 or more for Master students, KRW1,300,000 or more for Ph.D. students, KRW1,000,000 for Ph.D. candidates who have finished coursework) and some incentives on the basis of research achievement.

F Important Notes

- 1) Before applying for the graduate program at INJE, applicants should contact the staff in charge of international student's admission in order to discuss his/her admission.
- 2) If any of the required documents are missing or contain false information, the admission may be rescinded.
- 3) All documents should be written in English or Korean. Documents written in other languages should be accompanied by a notarized English or Korean translation.
- 4) Applicants whose graduation is pending at another institution during the time of application, should submit the Graduation Certificate(s) and the Degree Certificate(s) before his/her first semester begins.
- 5) If the accepted students received their degree from abroad, they must submit a diploma copy with apostilled certificates (if applicable) or consular confirmation by the Korean embassy of the country where the institution is located before their first semester begins.
 - In case of the applicant who received their degree from a university in China, they should obtain and submit the online verification report at the website of China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (www.cdgc.edu.cn) or at the website of China Higher-education student Information (www.chsi.com.cn).
 - Accepted students residing in Korea with a D-4 visa are advised to prepare 2 copies of the above documents, One for immigration and one for the school.
- 6) After being admitted to the school, freshmen must purchase national health insurance. For those who do not pay national health insurance fees in Korea, their application for the dormitory, scholarship, class registration, and visa extension/change will be nullified.





- 2) Light Rail Inje Station → Transfer to Subway Daejo Station Line 3 from Gyeongjeon Subway Daejo Station → Transfer to Subway Line 2 from Suyeong Station → Get off at Gwangan Station
